

## **TERNA: REORGANISATION OF THE NETWORK BETWEEN RIMINI AND RICCIONE UNDERWAY. NEW UNDERGROUND CONNECTIONS AND 40 KM OF OVERHEAD LINES DEMOLISHED**

**The company led by Giuseppina Di Foggia will invest €60 million in efficient and sustainable infrastructure**

**Construction will begin in the first quarter of 2026 for the construction of 17 km of new underground power lines.**

**The demolition of 171 pylons in densely populated areas is planned to restore 130 hectares of urban space.**

**Rome, 06 November 2025** – Terna has completed the executive design for the redevelopment project known as '132 kV Rimini – Riccione Link', which will involve a total of eight municipalities in Romagna between the provinces of Rimini and Forlì-Cesena, and has published a notice listing the plots of land affected by the future opening of the construction sites.

The project, in which the company led by Giuseppina Di Foggia will invest €60 million, aims to make the electricity system in the area safer and more efficient, particularly during summer, when local electricity consumption rises considerably due to a high tourist presence and a resulting rise in energy demand for hospitality and services.

The environmental benefits will also be significant: thanks to the installation of around 17 km of new underground cables, it will be possible to demolish over 40 km of old overhead lines in total and to remove 171 pylons dating back to the 1970s, running through densely populated areas. The result will be over 130 hectares of land freed up from electrical infrastructure.

During the first quarter of 2026, Terna will open construction sites in the Municipalities of Riccione and Coriano, where around 8 km of new cables are to be laid and 3 new supports installed. These and other measures involved in the project will allow the demolition of 48 pylons and over 8 km of old overhead power lines.

At a later point, the work will also involve the Municipality of Rimini, with the laying of around 10 km of new underground power lines and the installation of 2 supports, which will clear the way for more than 20 km of overhead lines and 84 pylons to be cleared.

The benefits of the restructuring will also extend to other Municipalities: Santarcangelo di Romagna, with the demolition of 17 pylons and around 4 km of old electricity lines; Savignano sul Rubicone, where 14 pylons and around 3 km of old power lines will be removed; Gatteo, which will be freed up from 6 supports and around 2 km of line each; and Gambettola, where 2 supports will be demolished.
